- Review the 2020 State Team feedback
- Assist formulating the draft 2021 State Team Selection policy and key dates to be endorsed by the Rowing SA Board
- Select coaches, rowers and coxswains in the appropriate crews and squads to represent South Australia at the Interstate Regatta and Pathway Regatta
- Promote equal access to all nominees through the selection process
- Adhere to the Rowing SA Code of Conduct

## **Additional Responsibilities**

- Attend training sessions with crews and coaches
- Attend Selectors and Coaches meetings
