<b>POSITION PURPOSE</b>	
<p>The Masters State Team Selection Panel (MSTSP) made up of three (3) Selectors is to select coaches, squads, and final teams to be recommended to the Rowing SA Board who will represent South Australia at the <u>Interstate (Masters) Regatta</u>.</p> <p>The MSTSP will ensure that all selection events are conducted in a fair, professional manner, giving equal opportunity to all nominees to be selected onto the SA Masters State Team.</p>	
<b>KEY RESPONSIBILITIES</b>	
<p><b>Specific Duties</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review the 2021 State Team feedback</li> <li>• Assist formulating the draft 2022 State Team Selection policy and key dates to be endorsed by the Rowing SA Board</li> <li>• Select coaches, rowers and coxswains in the appropriate crews and squads to represent South Australia at the Interstate Regatta and Pathway Regatta</li> <li>• Promote equal access to all nominees through the selection process</li> <li>• Adhere to the Rowing SA Code of Conduct</li> </ul> <p><b>Additional Responsibilities</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend training sessions with crews and coaches</li> <li>• Attend Selectors and Coaches meetings</li> </ul>	
<b>HOURS OF WORK</b>	Hours required to fulfil the full duties and responsibilities are flexible and is expected to be between 2-10 hours per week (February 2022 – May 2022). This includes the requirement to attend meetings with athletes and coaches.
<b>REMUNERATION</b>	This is a voluntary position
