- Nominations are to include a digital profile image of the nominee (for the individual awards. Please ensure all nominee photographs are from the shoulders up and of a high-resolution quality.
- The award criteria is listed in the Rowing SA Rules and Regulations, available on our website.

Award Categories

Club Coach of the Year: to be awarded to a current RA accredited coach who has demonstrated an ability to develop themselves, has an outstanding record of achievement during the season, and who has contributed to the development of the sport and the wellbeing and success of its competitors.

Community Club Person: to be awarded to a club member who has made the most significant impact on their local community by demonstrating respect, initiative, and personal commitment to the sport of rowing and to their club. This person has demonstrated their ability to work as part of a team and is well respected amongst their peers/club mates.
